An ambitious project breathing new life into a century-old building: a decarbonized, sustainable, and fully accessible space for everyone. An unifying hub bringing together community-based health and social services, social economy organizations, and cultural venues.

Key Figures:

- 26 000** sq. ft. of affordable, universally accessible space, including a multifunctional and event hall, a terrace, and more.
- +10** non-profits and social economy enterprises inhabiting the space.
- +20 000** annual visitors.
- +25** lasting new services in the neighbourhood.
- +80** jobs maintained.
- +40** endorsements from local and national stakeholders, elected officials and civil society.

Why Support This Project?

Intolerance toward LGBTQ+ communities is intensifying, adding to the already complex Village's reality:

- **400%** increase in hate crimes in Canada since 2018
- **68 %** of residents consider the Village unsafe or very unsafe
- **23 non-profits** at risk of losing their premises
- **40 %** population increase in the neighbourhood within 10 years, putting pressure on current coexistence dynamics

Espace LGBTQ+ Already In Action:

- Transformation of a vacant building into a safe, inclusive, and accessible space.
- A community complex aligned with the Village's economic and social recovery strategy.
